

Rainwater tank

IMPORTANT: ALWAYS wear rubber gloves and goggles

DANGER CHLORINE



- 1 Work out how much water is in the tank.
- 2 For every 1000 Litres in a tank use approximately 40 millilitres of **liquid pool chlorine** (12.5% available chlorine)
Or For every 1000 Litres in a tank use approximately 170 millilitres of **bleach**

IMPORTANT: Only use non perfumed chlorine bleach such as White King

- 3 Dilute the chlorine/bleach in a plastic bucket

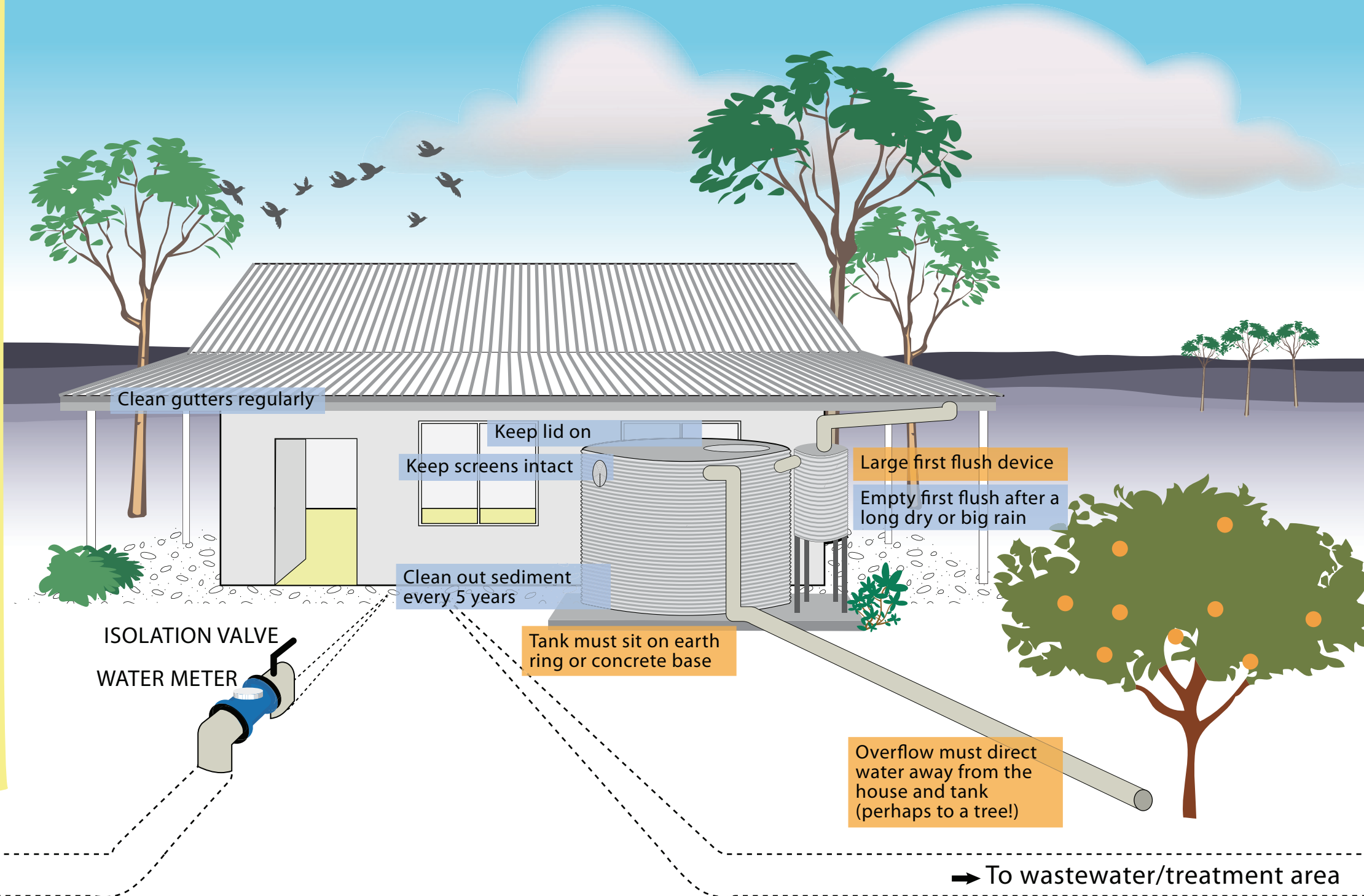
IMPORTANT: ALWAYS ADD THE CHLORINE TO THE WATER...(NEVER THE WATER TO THE CHLORINE)

- 4 Use a jug to spread the chlorine or bleach across the whole surface of the tank using a casting motion to ensure it is distributed evenly.
- 5 Stir the tank (if possible) to mix in the chlorine/bleach

Let stand for approximately 24 hrs

- 6 Test the tank before drinking to ensure chlorine level is okay. Use pool test strips if the strip turns pale pink it is okay to use.

If not okay wait 12 hours and retest.
